Schedules for these events must be sent to the FEI Secretariat for approval by the NF concerned, latest 8 weeks before the event is due to take place.

Definite schedules must be sent to the FEI Secretariat by the NFs concerned 4 weeks before the event takes place.

Final approval of this draft schedule by the FEI, in accordance with Art. 115.1, denotes only that the contents are conform to the FEI Statutes, General Regulations and Rules. By no means does this entail implicit acceptance of any liability of the FEI for any damages to third parties caused by the Organising Committee and its

officials, riders, drivers, owners, and their horses.
