**WRAL Classes:** - AQHA rules are applied with following exceptions:

- Youth -18 may also enter the Beginner, Amateur and Open Division. Youth may show **twohanded** in Snafflebit or Hackamore or **onehanded** on a Bit even senior horses.
- No stallions are allowed in Youth-Classes
- The Beginner division is reserved exclusively for competitors who are eligible to have or get a AQHA-NOVICE Amateur, AQHA-NOVICE Youth or NRHA-ROOKIE card.
- Beginner may show **twohanded** in Snafflebit or Hackamore or **onehanded** on a Bit even senior horses.
- In all WRAL-classes the horse does not need to be owned by the competitor.
- Trail in Hand APHA rules will be applied

**FLSE classes: (just for FLSE licensed riders):** AQHA rules are applied with the following exception:

- In Youth and Open classes the horse does not need to be owned by the competitor.
- The competitor needs to own an FLSE Western or Competition license, the horse does not need be registered.
