Show-office is open on Friday September 19th from 20.00 h to 22.00h. and open on September 20 and 21. at 7:30h.

*Classes start on both days at 8 :00 a.m. ( Starting time may change, changes will be announced in Show office)*

**WRAL Classes:** - AQHA rules are applied with following exceptions:

- Youth -18 may also enter the Beginner, Amateur and Open Division. Youth may show **twohanded** on Snafflebit or Hackamore or **onehanded** on a Bit even senior horses.
- No stallions are allowed in Youth-Classes
- The Beginner division is reserved exclusively for competitors who have not won more than 3 times that class ( Results of WRAL Beginner, WRAL-Amateur and WRAL-Open are added, minimum of 3 entries),
- Beginner may show **twohanded** on Snafflebit or Hackamore or **onehanded** on a Bit even senior horses.
- WRAL-Beginner and WRAL-Amateur may run concurrently,
- In all WRAL-classes the horse does not need to be owned by the competitor.
- Trail in Hand APHA rules will be applied
- Horse&Dog-Trail EWU rules will be applied (Western- or English-Dress allowed)

**AQHA and NRHA classes:**

- Classes are judged according to their respective rules.
- For AQHA::: Rider has to send in the required valid membership card (or buy it at the show) as well as a copy of the horse's registration certificate.
- For NRHA-Classes: Rider and Owner must send in a valid NRHA-membership card, Horse must have a NRHA Competition Licence.

**FLSE classes: (just for FLSE licensed riders):** AQHA rules are applied with the following exception:

- In Youth and Amateur classes the horse does not need to be owned by the competitor.
- The competitor needs to own an FLSE Western or Competition license, the horse does not need be registered.
- FLSE-classes may run concurrently with other classes
- Reining classes are judge according to FEI Rules

**Rights on Photos, Videos etc:**

- With the signature, each participant agrees that photos and or videos taken on the showground can be published.

**Doping, vaccinations animal welfare:** With the signature, each participant accepts that:
